Earn \$49,000 or less last year? You may qualify for EITC



Millions of workers could overlook a special federal tax credit because they don't know about it. **As a result, they could miss out on up to \$5,751 extra** in their federal income tax refunds through the Earned Income Tax Credit, or EITC. Last year, on average, the credit boosted refunds for eligible workers by \$2,100. Qualified workers can get free help determining their EITC eligibility and claiming the credit.

If you earned less than \$49,078 in 2011 with three or more qualifying children the government may owe you up to \$5,751.

If you are married, have no qualifying children and your income was less than \$18,740, the government may owe you up to \$464.

* Must earn \$49,000 or less (married couple filing jointly) to qualify for free tax preparation
