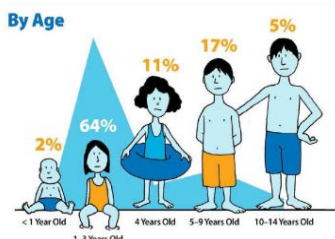

DROWNING PREVENTION BEGINS WITH LEARNING TO SWIM



Drowning is the fifth-leading cause of death in the United States. In Broward County, it is the leading cause of unintentional death among children ages 1 to 4.

Don't let yourself or a loved one become a part of this statistic by following this simple checklist:

- ⚙️ **Learn how to swim.** Formal swimming lessons can reduce the risk of drowning especially among children age 1 to 14. The Weston YMCA and other facilities throughout Broward honor the [Swim Central coupon](#) for children ages 6 months to 4 years old. A limited number of adult swim vouchers are also available. - ⚙️ **Make pool safety something to brag about.** Be sure to keep your pool area covered, install pool alarms and install a pool barrier. Be sure the barrier is always closed when not in use.
- ⚙️ **Be a Water Watcher.** There must always be a dedicated ADULT to supervise when children are near water, including the pool area, beach, backyard lakes, canals and even the bathtub.
