CITY COMMISSION TO HONOR RETIRING FIRE CHIEF JOHN FRAILEY

John Frailey, Weston Fire Chief since July 2007, will be honored by the City Commission on Monday, March 15, 2010 at 7:00p.m.

Frailey, an Assistant Chief with the Broward County Sheriff's Office Department of Fire Rescue, serves as Fire Chief for the City of Weston. Weston contracts with the Broward Sheriff's Office for Fire & EMS services. Frailey began his career with Broward County in June 1980 as a Paramedic, raising through the ranks and now retiring after 30 years of dedicated service.

During his tenure with the City of Weston residents have benefited from numerous accomplishments, including his guidance in specifying, overseeing and taking delivery of the City's five EMS vehicles and five fire trucks. Chief Frailey was instrumental in obtaining an ISO Class 2 rating for the community, the implementation of the latest medical protocols, and under his supervision the achievement of a 100% fire inspection percentage of all multi-family and commercial buildings.



Weston has been very fortunate to have the leadership, experience and devotion of Chief Frailey and residents will continue to receive excellent fire, rescue and fire prevention services through new incoming Chief, Harris Bouchillon who will take the helm on April 3, 2010.
