9/11 ALWAYS REMEMBERED

Weston Town Center Park Amphitheater

The City of Weston is honored to host *9/11 ALWAYS REMEMBERED* a community-wide event commemorating the 10th anniversary of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks upon the United States.

This one-hour event will include federal, state and local leaders, the Broward Sheriff's Office, members of the Weston Clergy Group, the Police Pipe & Drum Corp, helicopter fly over, the Cypress Bay Choir, a moment of silence and dove release. A memorable addition to the program will be a 460 pound piece of steel on display which was a part of the destroyed World Trade Center Towers, on loan to the City by St. Katharine Drexel Church who secured this piece of history from the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey for public viewing.

This event will honor and commemorate all victims who lost their lives on that tragic day, those emergency responders who risked their own lives to save others, as well as pay tribute to those who continue to defend our country and provide safety and security each day.

We invite the public to join us in this one-hour tribute, as we stand together in reflection and in appreciation, as we look to our future but never forget the past.

Also on display along the Town Center Park waterfront will be special flags created for the 10th Anniversary of 9/11 by the Flag of Honor/Flag of Heroes Project.

The event will take place at the Weston Town Center Park Amphitheater which is located at 1900 Bell Tower Lane in the Weston Town Center.

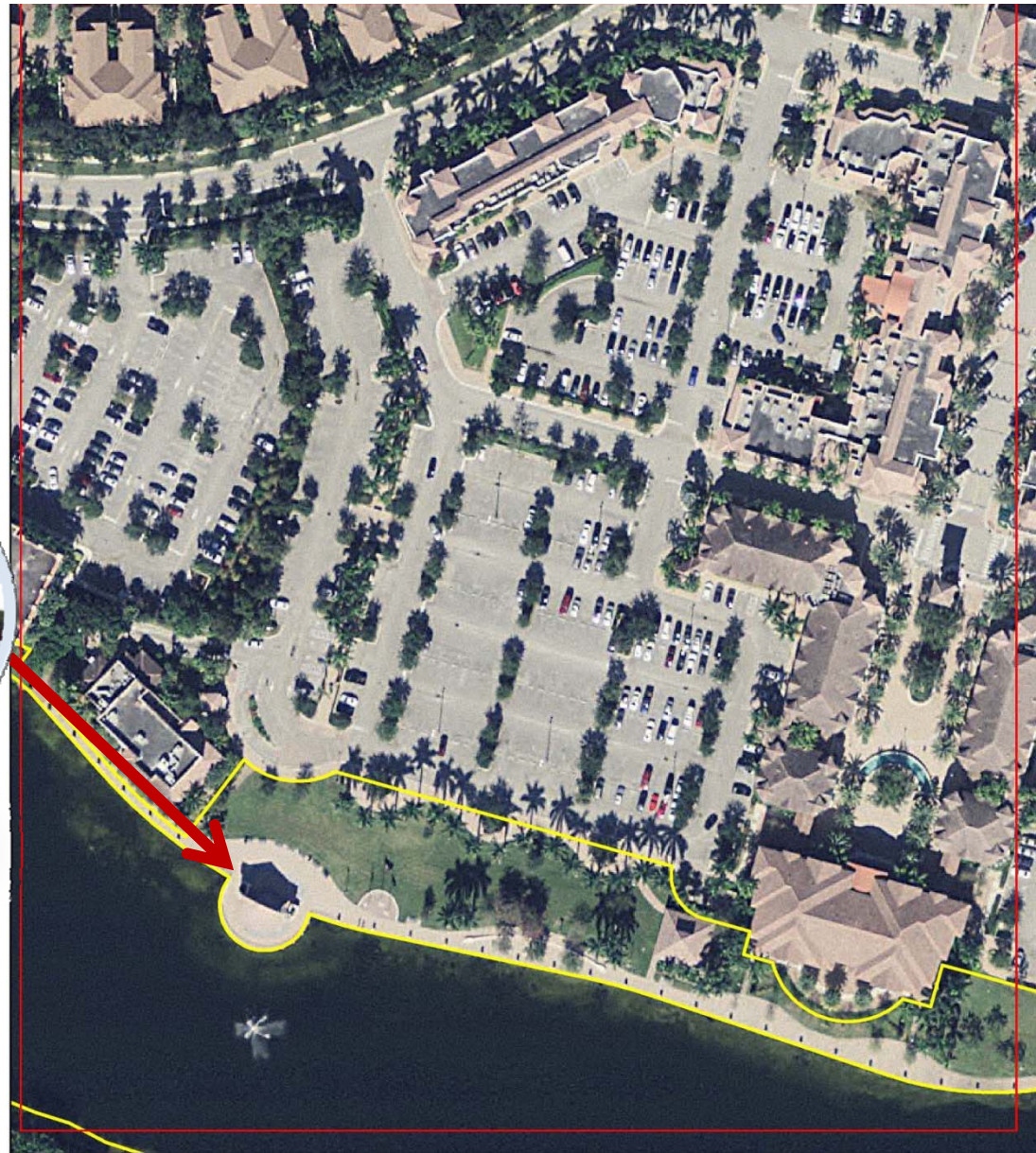
