RESOLUTION NO. 2025-06**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AWARDED BID NO. 2024-10 FOR INDIAN TRACE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS SURTAX-FUNDED MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT NUMBER WEST-192/193 TO PEDRAIL SYSTEMS, LLC OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, First, on September 24, 2018, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2018-129, approving the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (“ILA”) with Broward County (“County”), the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (“MPO”), and other Broward municipalities (“Municipalities”), for purposes of implementing the transportation surtax; and

WHEREAS, Second, on July 1, 2019, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2019-76, approving the First Amendment to the ILA with the County, the MPO, and the Municipalities for purposes of implementing the transportation surtax; and

WHEREAS, Third, on March 1, 2021, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2021-20, approving the Second Amendment to the ILA with the County, the MPO, and the Municipalities to fully restate the Interlocal Agreement, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Fourth, on June 6, 2022, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2022-63 approving the Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City of Weston (the “Agreement”) for Surtax-Funded Municipal Transportation Project: Design of Roadway Improvements to Indian Trace Road from Saddle Club Road to SW 160th Avenue, Surtax Project Number West-192/193 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, Fifth, on November 20, 2023, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-133, granting the City Manager the authority to execute time extension related amendments to the Surtax interlocal agreements; and

WHEREAS, Sixth, on December 11, 2023, the First Amendment to the Agreement extended the Project’s design phase term to October 28, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Seventh, on October 21, 2024, the City Commission adopted Resolution No.2024-149 approving the Second Amendment to the Agreement, extending the term of the Agreement through the end of the construction phase and providing surtax funding in the amount of \$3,460,549.00; and

WHEREAS, Eighth, funding was appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2024 and Fiscal Year 2025 Capital Projects Fund – Surtax Funded Capital Outlay; and

WHEREAS, Ninth, Broward County’s Office of Economic and Small Business Development (OESBD), pursuant to the Project Funding Agreement, applied a 30% County Business Enterprise (CBE) goal on the Project and declared that the Project is not subject to the Broward County Workforce Investment Program or the Broward County Construction Apprenticeship Program; and

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AWARDING BID NO. 2024-10 FOR INDIAN TRACE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS SURTAX-FUNDED MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT NUMBER WEST-192/193 TO PEDRAIL SYSTEMS, LLC OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Tenth, Chapter 32 of the City Code governs the acquisition of goods and services and disposal of City property, including Indian Trace Roadway Improvements Surtax-Funded Municipal Transportation Project Number West-192/193, Bid No. 2024-10 (the "Bid"); and

WHEREAS, Eleventh, in compliance with Chapter 32 of the City Code, beginning on September 19, 2024, the Bid was issued and advertised in the Sun-Sentinel, on the City's website, and posted on the Public Notices board in the City Hall lobby, and bid documents made available for electronic download from the City's website and Onvia DemandStar; and

WHEREAS, Twelfth, on October 1, 2024 a total of twelve (12) individuals from a total of eleven (11) firms participated at the mandatory Pre-Bid Conference held virtually through Cisco Webex; and

WHEREAS, Thirteenth, on October 16, 2024, the City issued Addendum #1, on October 25, 2024 Addendum No. 2 was issued, on November 1, 2024 Addendum No. 3 was issued, and on November 7, 2024, Addendum #4 was issued; and

WHEREAS, Fourteenth, on November 14, 2024, bids were due and opened and the City received three (3) sealed bids from Pedrail Systems, LLC of Hialeah, Florida; Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. of Pembroke Pines, Florida; and Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. of West Palm Beach, Florida, as shown on the Bid Tabulation, attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Fifteenth, on December 10, 2024, the Selection Committee, consisting of Thaddeus Bielecki, Director of Landscaping; Ryan Fernandes, Director of Technology Services; and Francisco Lopez, Parks Superintendent, met at a publicly noticed virtual meeting held using Cisco Webex, to review the bids; and

WHEREAS, Sixteenth, the Selection Committee deemed all three firms as responsive and responsible and determined Pedrail Systems, LLC of Hialeah, Florida as the responsive and responsible bidder with the lowest cost in the total amount of \$3,689,396.75; and

WHEREAS, Seventeenth, the City Commission finds that the responsible and responsive bidder with the lowest cost for Bid No. 2024-10 for Indian Trace Roadway Improvements Surtax-Funded Municipal Transportation Project Number West-192/193, is Pedrail Systems, LLC of Hialeah, Florida, with the total bid amount of \$3,689,396.75.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.



Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.


