RESOLUTION NO. 2025-91**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AND AS THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE INDIAN TRACE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, AWARDING BID NO. 2025-03 FOR WESTON DRAINAGE DITCH NO. 3 & 5 RESTORATION, TO BDI MARINE CONTRACTORS, LLC OF HOBE SOUND, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, First, the Indian Trace Development District (ITDD) is a dependent special district of the City of Weston ("City") for the purpose of exercising all those rights, powers and authority contained in Chapter 189 and 190, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Second, the City Commission of the City of Weston serves as the governing board of the Indian Trace Development District; and

WHEREAS, Third, the City owns, operates and maintains drainage Ditch 5 and Ditch 3 in the project area located within the City; and

WHEREAS, Fourth, on October 16, 2023, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-109, approving Standard Grant Agreement Number 22FRP140, between the State of Florida, Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Weston, for the Florida Resilient Grant Program for Drainage Restoration; and

WHEREAS, Fifth, on November 18, 2024, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2024-166 approving the First Amendment to the Agreement between the State of Florida, Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Weston, for the Florida Resilient Grant Program funding for City of Weston Drainage Restoration in the amount of \$1,043,934.00, consisting of \$521,967.00 in Florida Resilient Grant Program funds and \$521,967.00 in City of Weston matching funds; and

WHEREAS, Sixth, funding was appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2025 Capital Projects Fund – Surtax Funded Capital Outlay; and

WHEREAS, Seventh, Chapter 32 of the City Code governs the acquisition of goods and services and disposal of City property, including Weston Drainage Ditch No. 3 & 5 Restoration, Bid No. 2025-03 (the "Bid"); and

WHEREAS, Eighth, in compliance with Chapter 32 of the City Code, beginning on April 24, 2025, the Bid was issued and advertised in the Sun-Sentinel, on the City's website, and posted on the Public Notices board in the City Hall lobby, and bid documents made available for electronic download from the City's website and Onvia DemandStar; and

WHEREAS, Ninth, on April 24, 2025 a total of nine (9) firms participated in the mandatory Pre-Bid Conference held virtually through Cisco Webex; and

WHEREAS, Tenth, on May 15, 2025 the City issued Addendum #1, on May 23, 2025 Addendum No. 2 was issued, on May 30, 2025 Addendum No. 3 was issued, and on June 4, 2025 Addendum No. 4 was issued; and

WHEREAS, Eleventh, on June 9, 2025, bids were due and opened and the City received four (4) sealed bids from American Design Engineering Construction, Inc. of Weston, Florida; BDI Marine Contractors, LLC of Hobe Sound, Florida; Emerald Construction Corporation dba Neucor Construction, of Hallandale Beach, Florida; and Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. of Pembroke Pines, Florida, as shown on the Bid Tabulation, attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Twelfth, on July 8, 2025, the Selection Committee, consisting of Ryan Fernandes, Director of Technology Services; Thaddeus Bielecki, Director of Landscaping; and Ingrith Salazar, Accountant II, met at a publicly noticed virtual meeting held using Cisco Webex, to review the bids; and

WHEREAS, Thirteenth, the Selection Committee deemed all four (4) firms as responsive and responsible and determined BDI Marine Contractors, LLC of Hobe Sound, Florida as the responsive and responsible bidder with the lowest cost in the total amount of \$925,080.00; and

WHEREAS, Fourteenth, the City Commission finds that the responsible and responsive bidder with the lowest cost for Bid No. 2025-03 for Weston Drainage Ditch No. 3 & 5 Restoration, is BDI Marine Contractors, LLC of Hobe Sound, Florida, with the total bid amount of \$925,080.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida, and as the governing board of the Indian Trace Development District:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2: Bid No. 2025-03 for Weston Drainage Ditch No. 3 & 5 Restoration is awarded to BDI Marine Contractors, LLC of Hobe Sound, Florida, the lowest responsible and responsive bidder with a total bid amount of \$925,080.00.

Section 3: The appropriate City officials are authorized to execute all necessary documents and to take any necessary action to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
