To All Bidders:

Bidders for the above referenced BID shall take note of the following changes, additions, deletions, clarifications, etc., to the BID documents, which shall become a part of and have precedence over anything shown or described otherwise.

A. CHANGES IN THE BID DOCUMENTS

B. CLARIFICATIONS

C. QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

- 1) Q: For the Professional Surveyor License portion of the requirements, we employ a separate contractor in Florida that has the proper licensing when we work, we pursue work in Florida. Is this acceptable for the licensing requirement?

A: The firm bidding shall be a licensed Surveyor/Mapper.

- 2) Q: Are Broward County CC and BTR also required to bid, or do we just need to list them if we have them already?

A: Please list them and provide copies of each along with your bid submittal, as noted in the solicitation.

- 3) Q: A function of surveyors or mappers isn't to remove vegetation and refurbish the banks. Normally, that is based on a plan that we do the location and the topographic survey; and the bathymetric survey on your specification. A plan would be created and then normally the other functions would be performed based on those plans.

A: The primary intent of this project is to obtain a survey of the underwater topography of the City's waterways.

4) Q: On vegetation removal: if requested, could that be under a subcontractor of ours or an approved subcontractor of the City's?

A: If the primary bidder cannot perform vegetation removal, then a subcontractor can be utilized to perform the work.

5) Q: Will the cost of the vegetation removal then be approved by the City after negotiation?

A: The pricing for vegetation removal is provided for in the bid form (Line Item #2).

6) Q: Is it known how much vegetation removal is expected, it could be one day of work or ten days? Is there an expected amount where we can get a quote from a subcontractor?

A: The removal, if required, will be authorized in 1,000 l.f. segments as listed in Line Item #2 of the bid form.

7) Q: Because there are so many miles of waterway, you almost have to do the survey to find the vegetation. How are we going to be able to price the vegetation removal out just by viewing the site?

A: See response to #6 above.

8) Q: Our company does both services, but sometimes the services can be interrupted by the vegetation, and it is difficult to know what that is or what it is going to be until you do the survey. If there are a lot of weeds in the way, and it messes with the survey, how are we going to build that into the price without doing the survey in the first place? They are almost two separate jobs.

A: See response to #6 above.

9) Q: Does this bid have a payment and perform and bond requirement?

A: Yes. It is 100% of the contract value.
