Proposers for the above referenced BID shall take note of the following changes, additions, deletions, clarifications, etc., to the BID documents, which shall become a part of and have precedence over anything shown or described otherwise.

A. CHANGES IN THE BID DOCUMENTS

1. DOCUMENT 00800, SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS, is hereby replaced with the attached REVISED DOCUMENT 00800, SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS.
2. The “BID SUBMITTAL DEADLINE” Section of Document 00010-2, Notice to Bidders, is being changed to reflect a new deadline date as follows:

SUBMITTAL DEADLINE

Sealed bids shall be received by the Director of Procurement until **2:00 p.m. local time, on ~~December 1, 2025~~ December 4, 2025** the (“**Submittal Deadline**”) at the City of Weston, City Hall, located at 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida. The official clock at the City Hall reception desk shall govern. Bids received after this time shall be returned unopened. The sealed bids will be publicly opened at the City of Weston, City Hall after the Bid Submittal Deadline. Award of a Bid will be made at a City Commission meeting. The public opening of submittals may be viewed by the public via Cisco Webex as follows:

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B. CLARIFICATIONS

1. All written or graphical work products shall be provided to the CITY in PDF format, WCAG 2.1, Level AA, ADA compliant.

C. QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

1. Q: In regard to the licensing requirements for the above project, we at Florida Blacktop Inc. respectfully challenge the requirement that a General Contractor license is required. Pre Florida House Bill 735 (2021) and Senate Bill 1142 (2023) local jurisdictions are prohibited from imposing additional contractor licensing requirements for trades over local specialty licensing effective July 1, 2025, and prohibit municipalities from excluding qualified contractors holding state licenses for the same scope of work. Accordingly, we request confirmation that our State issued Underground Utilities License along with our Broward County Major Roads License, in addition to our FDOT Prequalification and our 40 plus years performing Road Resurfacing, Paving, Striping, and overall Civil work more that qualifies us to perform the scope of the above project.

A: The requirements stated in the Experience section of Document 00010, Notice the Bidders, shall remain unchanged. These are the requirements for any potential Bidder submitting a sealed Bid for this solicitation.

2. Q: In regard to the Independence Affidavit, how far back does the time frame of a relationship or contract with the CITY extend?

A: 5 Years.

3. Q: What is the estimated budget for the project?

A: Estimated budget is \$2,000,000.00.

4. Q: Is it possible to change the bid submittal due date?

A: Please view the revised Notice To Bidders.

5. Q: What are the proposed working hours; are nighttime hours acceptable?

A: Work hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday.

6. Q: Is the general contractor responsible for testing or is the CITY responsible?

A: The CONTRACTOR is responsible for testing/densities.

7. Q: When is the actual construction starting date?

A: Construction is expected to commence sometime in the first quarter of 2026.

8. Q: How many lanes can we work on at a time for the milling and paving portion?

A: Contractor shall always have at least one (1) lane open for travel in each direction. It is up to the means and methods of the Contractor to comply with this requirement. Should an emergency arise that requires the total closure of travel in any one direction, the City shall be contacted for prior approval.

9. Q: Bid Item No. 26 Rework base furnish & install 8" thick lime-rock base 4,500/SF. Does this item pertain or correspond to bid items 29 & 30 "roadway brick pavers (6400/SF)"? If so, the quantity does not match up to the pavers bid item quantity – please clarify bid item 26 as to where this work is proposed and inclusions?

A: The 4,500 SF quantity in Bid Item 26 is an allowance for lime rock road base rework for damaged base under an existing delaminated pavement. It does not correspond to Bid Items 29 & 30 which are replacements of the existing pavers and leveling sand.

10. Q: What are the work hours, daytime lane closure hours, nighttime lane closures and can we pave at nighttime?

A: Night and weekend work may be permissible but shall be subjected to obtaining prior approval from the City. Please see the revised Document 00800 - Supplemental Conditions attached to this Addendum.

11. Q: At the intersection of Royal Palm and Bonaventure we are to remove and replace the crosswalks with new pavers along with associated work. To minimize the impact of traffic, "can this work be done at night, and what are the hours?"

A: Night work here is permissible. Work will still need prior approval from the CITY 72 hours prior to the start of this work. Work hours may be between 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

12. Q: Roadway Pavers crosswalks and the bulb-outs: what is the color of the pavers?

A: Colors and patterns to be decided prior to start of construction

13. Q: Do the pavers in the crosswalks need polymeric sand to facilitate joint stabilization?

A: It is not specified in the plan but may be decided later. Standard sand filler is required but not polymeric.

14. Q: Is a builder's risk insurance required for this project?

A: Yes, if CONTRACTOR plans to stage or store equipment and/or materials on CITY grounds.

15. Q: Does Bid Items 16 through 22 Curb Ramps include a 6" lime-rock base? Also, does the City of Weston have an estimated quantity e.g. "SY" of each curb ramp bid item? Usually, this item is in a square yard quantity not per each – please clarify.

A: Bid Items 17 to 22 is a lump sum cost to construct each (EA) ramp per FDOT Index 522-002, ADA compliant and including the Weston truncated dome pavers tactile surface per Detail R-19A in the plan.

16. Q: Bid Item No. 23 & 24 F-Curb Remove and Replace 1,835/LF. Plan Sheet No. 9 indicates approx. 165/LF.? Does the City of Weston have locations to where the rest of the 1,670/ft is located at? The (F-Curb) item does not indicate any excavation if in proposed grass edge line of pavement. Please clarify. Also, the bid items indicate a 6" lime-rock base (curb pad). Plan sheet no. 3 under notes for Concrete is indicating a 4" base-rock pad, and plan sheet no. 22 shows a 4" curb pad. Please clarify as to the proposed thickness of the curb pads.

A: The CITY will identify and mark the locations prior to construction. The 1,670 LF extra quantity is an allowance for additional curbing needed and restoration of areas that may require root pruning. The Bid Item 24 states to furnish & install the curb including 6" lime rock base. A detailed drawing of the curb installation is also provided in the plan. The note on sheet 3 as well as the detail drawing on sheet 22 are minimum requirements. Bid Item 24 called for 6" thick lime rock base therefore the project required for 6" thick base for Type F curb.

**REVISED
DOCUMENT 00800
SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS**

1. Times of Work.

The CONTRACTOR shall note the following.

- a. Section 52.52(j) of the CITY's Code of Ordinance addressing "Prohibited Noise."

"Construction or repairing of Buildings or site Development. The erection (including Excavating), demolition, alteration, or repair of any Building to create a Loud and Raucous Noise other than between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on any weekday or Saturday."

- b. Normal work hours shall be considered to be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday. The CONTRACTOR shall be aware, plan and accommodate the following. It is the CONTRACTOR's responsibility to plan the Work accordingly and incorporate into the pricing in the Bid Proposal.
- 1) For school zone areas – No work shall take place in the vicinity of schools during drop-off and pick-up times. CONTRACTOR shall visit the location of work to familiarize themselves with the traffic patterns and times for all relevant schools, including Everglades Elementary School, Falcon Cove Middle School and Cypress Bay High School.
 - 2) Everglades Elementary School Hours from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. - No lane closures in the vicinity of the Everglades Elementary school before 8:00 am and between 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.
 - 3) Falcon Cove Middle School Hours from 9:25 a.m. to 3:55 p.m. - No lane closures in the vicinity of the Falcon Cove Middle School before 9:25 a.m., between 3:25 p.m. and 4:25 p.m.
 - 4) Cypress Bay High School Hours from 7:40 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. - No lane closures in the vicinity of Cypress Bay High School before 7:40 a.m. and between 2:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.
 - 5) The CONTRACTOR shall be aware that on occasions where schools have early release, the scheduled working hours will need to be adjusted.
 - 6) In the "vicinity" shall be defined as 1,000 feet north and south of the school (or accordingly).
 - 7) The CITY may allow work on a Saturday, with prior approval, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 - 8) The CITY may allow work on a Sunday, with prior approval from the CITY from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
 - 9) Night work will need prior approval from the CITY and approval will be in consideration of the proximity to the residential areas. Work hours may be between 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

2. Additional Work

The CITY may add additional milling, pavement and pavement markings of other CITY Streets while the CONTRACTOR is mobilized and payment shall be in accordance with Document 00500, Section 4.3 of the Agreement.
