C. QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

1. Q: Can you tell me where a person may take the vegetation that is removed? Does the survey have a compost facility that would maybe want the nutrient rich material? Or would this need haul to a landfill for disposal? And could you recommend one?

A: The CITY currently does not have a place to store the material for Compost. It would need to be hauled off and disposed of elsewhere.

2. Q: Based on our technical review, our understanding is that the primary scope of work is the bathymetric survey of the waterways. This scope may be supported by the use of our dual-frequency echo sounder data, which allows for sediment characterization and may reduce the need for extensive vegetation removal. We also note that the bid includes a vegetation removal component; however, our interpretation is that such removal is limited to specific sections and quantities as identified in the addendum, rather than full-channel rehabilitation beyond the quantities identified. Please confirm whether this interpretation is correct.

A: Yes, correct. Full-channel rehabilitation is not required.
