

## ADDENDUM NO. 1

RFQ TITLE: Professional Engineering Design Services Weston Various Locations – Sidewalk and ADA Improvements

To All Proposers:

Proposers for the above referenced RFQ shall take note of the following changes, additions, deletions, clarifications, etc., to the RFQ documents, which shall become a part of and have precedence over anything shown or described otherwise.

### A. CHANGES IN THE RFQ DOCUMENTS

- 1) The “QUALIFICATIONS” section of the Notice To Proposers, has been corrected to reflect the following:

#### QUALIFICATIONS

“PROPOSERS shall be professionally licensed to practice engineering in the State of Florida. PROPOSERS shall have been in continuous practice for a minimum of the immediate past ten (10) years and shall have completed ~~bicycle lane design~~ **sidewalk** design services for government agencies in Southeast Florida for projects similar in scope, size and complexity or greater as those services required in this solicitation. The PROPOSER should have experience with FDOT LAP Projects and shall be FDOT pre-qualified as specified within.”

- 2) Section 2.2, Licensing and Minimum Qualifications, paragraphs C. and D. of the solicitation is being changed to read as follows:

C. Experience - PROPOSERS shall be professionally licensed to practice engineering in the State of Florida. PROPOSERS shall have been in continuous practice for a minimum of the immediate past ten (10) years and shall have completed ~~bicycle lane~~ **sidewalk** design services for government agencies in Southeast Florida for projects similar in scope, size and complexity or greater, as those services required in this solicitation.

D. FDOT Pre-Qualification is required in the following FDOT Work Types:  
Major Work Type: 3.1  
Minor Work Types: ~~4.11~~ **4.1.1**, 7.1

The PROPOSER must be qualified in all major work types listed, sub consultants/subcontractors may be used to satisfy the qualifications in the minor work types.

- 3) Section 4.3, Sealed Proposal, section C, paragraph 1.- c. of the solicitation is being changed to read as follows:

c. Acknowledge and confirm the PROPOSER has been in continuous practice for a minimum of the immediate past ten (10) years, from the date that this RFQ is issued, in providing ~~bicycle lane~~ **sidewalk** design services for government agencies in Southeast Florida for projects similar in scope, size and complexity or greater as those services required in this solicitation and is professionally licensed to practice engineering in the State of Florida.

- 4) Section 1.1 of the Agreement document has been changed to read as follows:

1.1 The term of this Agreement shall begin on the date it is fully executed by both parties and shall extend until the development of the design services for ~~additional bicycle lanes~~ **sidewalks and ADA improvements** are completed in full and final payment is made to the CONSULTANT. The parties hereto may extend this Agreement by mutual consent, in writing, prior to the expiration of the current term.

## B. CLARIFICATIONS

## C. QUESTIONS FROM PROPOSERS

- 1) Q: Could the City please confirm if the FDOT Pre-Qualification solicited in the RFQ for Minor Work Types is 4.11 or 4.1.1?

A: The Minor Work Types should read 4.1.1.

- 2) Q: We reviewed the recent RFQ posted for AE services for Sidewalks and ADA Improvements and have a quick question. If known, what is the anticipated schedule for bidding and construction of this project?

A: Bidding for construction will begin in Spring 2027 with construction to begin in Summer 2027.

- 3) Q: Is there a page limit?

A: There is no specified page limit for the entire proposal, but several sections have specific page limits. Refer to the RFQ.

- 4) Q: For the Chapter 1 GSA Standard Form 330 Requirement – Is the whole form required? (Part I – A-H, Part II) if it is the whole form required, is there where we would include 330 Resumes, Projects, for subconsultants as well?

A: The whole form is required. 330 Resumes should only be provided for key personnel (shown by name and title on org chart) identified in Part 1. The 330 resumes and projects for subconsultants belong in Part 1, Sections E and F, respectively.

- 5) Q: Are there any forms to be completed by subconsultants?

A: Part 2 needs to be completed for each sub/company identified in your proposal. One of these will be for the prime and one should be completed for each sub.

6) Q: What is the estimated construction budget?

A: The estimated construction budget is \$3,000,000.00

7) Q: Are there any forms to be completed by subconsultants?

A: Part 2 needs to be completed for each sub/company identified in your proposal. One of these will be for the prime and one should be completed for each sub.

8) Q: Is the ONLY required form for subconsultants the Part II Architect Engineer Qualifications Standard 330 Form?

A: Yes

9) Q: If we wanted to be a subconsultant let's say for landscaping architecture services, is there a maximum number of firms or teams we can be on or unlimited?

A: No limit.

10) Q: Can you please provide the Engineer's estimate/construction budget for this project?

A: The estimate budget for the construction is \$3,000,000.00.

11) Q: Because of the sensitive nature of financial information, and knowing any RFP submittals becomes public record, does the CITY have a way of ensuring that the financial information provided does not become public record?

A: In accordance with Section 32.11 of the City Code, the financial statements submitted in response to this RFQ are exempt from public records.

12) Q: Could the financials be submitted in a separate package?

A: Yes.

13) Q: Will the CITY only be awarding one contract.

A: Yes.
