RESOLUTION NO. 2026-57**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AND AS THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE INDIAN TRACE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, AND AS THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE BONAVENTURE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, REJECTING THE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR RFP NO. 2026-01, ROADWAY TRAFFIC SIGNAGE MAINTENANCE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, First, the Indian Trace Development District and the Bonaventure Development District are dependent special districts of the City of Weston, for the purpose of exercising all those rights, powers and authority contained in Chapter 189 and 190, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Second, the City Commission of the City of Weston serves as the governing board of both the Indian Trace Development District and the Bonaventure Development District; and

WHEREAS, Third, funding is appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget, Street Maintenance Fund , Capital Maintenance – Traffic Signage Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Fourth, Chapter 32 of the City Code governs the acquisition of goods and services and disposal of City property, including Request for Proposal No. 2026-01 for Roadway Traffic Signage Maintenance Services (the “RFP”); and

WHEREAS, Fifth, in compliance with Chapter 32 of the City Code, on January 13, 2026, the RFP was issued and advertised in the Sun-Sentinel, on the City’s website, and posted on the Public Notices board in the City Hall lobby, and proposal documents made available for electronic download from the City’s website and Onvia DemandStar; and

WHEREAS, Sixth, on January 27, 2026 the non-mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference was held virtually through Cisco Webex but which resulted in having no attendees; and

WHEREAS, Seventh, on February 12, 2026 the City issued Addendum #1 extending the submittal due date to promote vendor participation, as no proposals had been received; and

WHEREAS, Eighth, on February 24, 2026 the City issued Addendum #2 extending the submittal due date once again to allow for additional vendor outreach; and

WHEREAS, Ninth, proposals were due and opened on March 3, 2026, which yielded proposals from the following two (2) firms: Doral Digital Reprographics Corp. of Doral, Florida and BLG Sign Company, LLC of Sunrise, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Tenth, the RFP provided that the proposals would be evaluated on the following criteria: 1) Proposer’s financial ability to perform the services described in the Agreement; 2) Qualifications of the Proposer’s personnel, project manager and subcontractors, including their pertinent training, skill and experience who may be providing services pursuant to the RFP and Agreement; 3) Proposer’s experience and performance on comparable contracts in providing

fabrication, installation, maintenance and repair of roadway traffic signage to other entities of similar complexity and size as the CITY and make sure it is consistent throughout the solicitation; 4) Compliance of Sample Sign Post to RFP design specifications which includes: post material type, post thickness, dimensions, sign blade vinyl material, welding quality and locations, ornamental details, proper paint color and coat thickness; and 5) PROPOSER's total cost of services as provided in the Exhibit B-Fee Schedule Table; and

WHEREAS, Eleventh, on April 6, 2026, the Selection Committee, consisting of Bryan Cahen, Director of Budget; Kara Petty, Director of Parks and Recreation; and Pamela Solomon, Assistant Director of Communications, met at a publicly noticed meeting and recommended that both firms be deemed non-responsive and rejected, for failure to submit a proposal security bond and other required documentation in accordance with the RFP; and

WHEREAS, Twelfth, Section 2.17 of the RFP document, provides that the City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals if found by the City Commission not to be in the best interest of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, Thirteenth, the City Commission finds it in the best interest of the City to reject all proposals received in response to this solicitation and to terminate the Selection Committee, pursuant to Section 32.02(A)(2) of the Code; and to terminate the Cone of Silence, pursuant to Section 32.10(C) of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida, and as the governing board of the Indian Trace Development District, and as the governing board of the Bonaventure Development District:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2: The City Commission rejects the proposals received in response to this solicitation.

Section 3: The Selection Committee is terminated pursuant to Section 32.02(A)(2) of the Code.

Section 4: The Cone of Silence is terminated pursuant to Section 32.10(C) of the Code.

Section 5: The appropriate City officials are authorized to execute all necessary documents and to take any necessary action to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 6: This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.


