- You must participate by connecting through **Option (D) above, via the Cisco Webex Event.** As an attendee, you are requested to register your name and email address before logging in. At specific moments during the meeting, you will be able to "raise hand" to notify the meeting Host that you wish to speak either during Public Comment or on any Agenda item. You must first open the "participants" list to see the "raise hand" icon next to your name in the list. The "participant's" icon is one of the icons on the bottom of the screen while a meeting is in progress. To raise your hand, hover over your name in the participants list and select "raise hand". A small hand icon will be placed next to your name in the participants list. The meeting Host will individually unmute each attendee in the queue to speak. Each speaker will be allowed up to 3 minutes. Please note, public attendees will only have audio capabilities during the meeting. Video streaming of individuals is reserved for the City Commission and Staff.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT COMMISSION MEETINGS

Anyone wishing to address the Commission with regards to a matter appearing on the Agenda or during public comments is requested to sign in with the City Manager or his designee. Each individual is requested to state his or her name and the name of the entity represented (if applicable) and the item on the agenda to be addressed prior to conclusion of the discussion of the matter. Each person addressing the Commission shall approach the lectern, is requested to give their name and address in an audible tone of voice for the record, and unless further time is granted by the Presiding Officer for all people speaking on the item, shall limit their address to three (3) minutes. A person speaking on an item on the agenda shall limit their comments to matters relevant to the item. A person speaking during public comments shall only speak on matters pertaining to the City, shall not address any item on the agenda and is strongly encouraged to refrain from making political statements or making personal attacks on any member of the Commission or any other individuals or entities. No person, other than the Commission and the person having the floor, shall be permitted to enter any discussion, either directly or through a member of the Commission, without the permission of the Presiding Officer. No question shall be asked of a Commissioner except through the Presiding Officer.

Any person who addresses the Commission on behalf of an individual, corporation or special interest group for compensation must disclose that representation when stating his or her name, as described above.

Pursuant to Florida Statutes 286.0105, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the body with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
